Content of lessons:

bMoved sessions are designed to include a wide array of music and dance styles. The experience is to introduce your child to the excitement of the wonderful world of music and dancing, alongside developing their own unique personality and stage presence. Each child is engaged, and their confidence levels naturally soar.

Participants have fun whilst learning the elements of music and various dance styles such as Hip Hop, Line Dance and Zumba. Classes include famous and popular dances (Folk dances, Popular Party dances, latest music dance crazes, basics of Ballroom and Latin, Zumba etc....).

Children also enjoy singing popular songs, play basic rhythms on Boomwhackers and other percussion instruments, participate in fun-filled general musical knowledge sessions, as well as stimulating uniquely developed music games. Team building activities embody the vision in all areas of these sessions and many activities involving group work are incorporated.

Please bear in mind that NO parents, family, friends, etc. are allowed to watch the lessons. The presence of an audience each week becomes disruptive. An open day(s) will be arranged during the course of the year for you to view your child's progress. You are more than welcome to pop into the last five minutes of each lesson to 'sneak a peek'. Thank you for your co-operation.

CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Fees are payable in advance (by the first week of each ten-week schedule). Thereafter, if fees are not settled children may no longer continue taking part in these lessons.
- 2) Fees are payable directly to Mrs Bianca Crawford **ONLY**, not the school secretary / class teacher / Clubhouse Management as this is a private extra mural. Monies often get lost if sent elsewhere. If you cannot personally deliver cash payments, please kindly make a direct transfer.
- 3) Please ensure payments are made in Cash (in person only, not via the school / clubhouse) or via direct transfer (EFT) into my account. Please your child's name and surname as the reference for any online payments.

- 6) No lessons on public holidays and during school holidays.
- 7) **NO PARENTS** are allowed to watch the music and dance classes. I will inform you about any open days.
- 8). No concerts or shows are offered in this activity. It is a fun, social, stimulating activity – children benefit physically, mentally and emotionally by dancing, singing and playing musical instruments with other children. Various The option of fun-family events and or open days will be discussed during the course of the year.
- 9). Children are advised to bring a bottle of water to these lessons (some activities may get quite physical), and dress comfortably (School PT uniform is ideal and recommended if activity is at a school). NO LONG SKIRTS, DRESSES, MINI SKIRTS OR SKIMPY TOPS PLEASE GIRLS! Dress comfortably e.g. T-shirt and leggings in summer and Tracksuit in winter. TACKIES NB!! Grade 1's and 2's are to wear school uniform (you can pack tackies if so wished) as this activity takes place as soon as the end of the day bell goes at 1pm. This also minimises the little ones losing their school clothing items.
- 10) A detailed ten-week schedule will be sent home / emailed / WhatsApp'ed to each family. Please make sure you follow this schedule on a weekly basis to avoid attending classes when there aren't any available / I am away / the school or clubhouse is closed. Thank you!
